



Key Highlights:

- Birgunj Metropolitan City (BMC) organized an interaction program on cholera outbreak response, control measures, and school reopening, with technical support from WHO and UNICEF.
- Provincial Health Directorate continues close coordination with the local level, District Health Office, and Narayani Hospital for gap identification and resource mobilization.
- RCCE/SBC activities and active case finding are ongoing under BMC leadership, with support from NRCS, UNICEF, nursing students, and BMC staff, reaching over 3,500 households to date.
