




Highlights

Among the reported diseases, **AGE** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 19 with **696** reported cases.

Overall reporting rate of Week 19 is **96.6%** with 114 out of 118 sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.


1003564 cases of Corona Virus Disease (Covid-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 991509 cases have been so far.




This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.

Summary Observation

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KAILALI (61 cases), PARSА (55 cases), KATHMANDU (47 cases), KAPILBASTU (38 cases) and RUPANDEHI (35 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (48 cases), MORANG (23 cases), RUPANDEHI (21 cases), KAILALI (15 cases) and DHADING (15 cases).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from JHAPA (11 cases), CHITAWAN (9 cases), TANAHU (5 cases), KATHMANDU (5 cases) and DANG (3 cases).

Malaria Falciparum cases were reported from RAUTAHAT (1 cases).

Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from RAUTAHAT (2 cases), SURKHET (1 cases), KALIKOT (1 cases), PALPA (1 cases) and BAGLUNG (1 cases).

Cholera cases were reported from RAUTAHAT (1 cases).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from DADEL DHURA (12 cases), OKHALDHUNGA (8 cases), DARCHULA (7 cases), LAMJUNG (5 cases) and CHITAWAN (4 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from DADEL DHURA (13 cases), ROLPA (5 cases), JHAPA (5 cases), BAITADI (4 cases) and SURKHET (4 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from ACHHAM (35 cases), SINDHUPALCHOK (9 cases), RASUWA (8 cases), BAJURA (6 cases) and LALITPUR (6 cases).
