




## Highlights


Among the reported diseases, **AGE** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 30 with **599 reported cases**.

Overall reporting rate of Week 30 is **94.0%** with **126 out of 134** sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.




This bulletin includes data since January 2022 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. In May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting. Recently, in November 2024, 17 reporting sites selected from all the provinces of Nepal were upgraded to sentinel sites, thus the number of sentinel sites are increasing. The current number of sentinel sites is 134.

### Summary Observation (including probable and suspect cases)

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (80 cases), PARSA (50 cases), BHAKTAPUR (32 cases), KAILALI (25 cases) and RUPANDEHI (23 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (38 cases), RUPANDEHI (18 cases), BHAKTAPUR (13 cases), PARSA (13 cases) and SOLUKHUMBU (10 cases).

Most of the **Cholera** cases were reported from BHAKTAPUR (4 cases), DOLAKHA (4 cases), KHOTANG (4 cases), RUPANDEHI (2 cases) and GULMI (2 cases).

Most of the **Malaria** cases were reported from KAILALI (5 cases), RUPANDEHI (1 case), KATHMANDU (1 case) and BARA (1 case).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KASKI (17 cases), KATHMANDU (17 cases), PALPA (14 cases), LAMJUNG (8 cases) and SUNSARI (6 cases).

Most of the **Kala azar** cases were reported from JAJARKOT (1 case), DAILEKH (1 case), BARDIYA (1 case), CHITAWAN (1 case) and TAPLEJUNG (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from ACHHAM (51 cases), DANG (24 cases), SANKHUWASABHA (22 cases), DOTI (21 cases) and PALPA (20 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from KAILALI (57 cases), KANCHANPUR (23 cases), KATHMANDU (13 cases), DARCHULA (12 cases) and PALPA (8 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from KAILALI (58 cases), ACHHAM (33 cases), BAJURA (25 cases), DAILEKH (21 cases) and PARBAT (20 cases).
