


### **Highlights**


Among the reported diseases, **SARI** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 42 with **490 reported cases**.


Overall reporting rate of Week 42 is **91.8%** with **123 out of 134** sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2023 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. In May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting. Recently, in November 2024, 17 reporting sites selected from all the provinces of Nepal were upgraded to sentinel sites, thus the number of sentinel sites have increased. The current number of sentinel sites is 134.

#### Summary Observation (including probable and suspect cases)

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (37 cases), PARSA (28 cases), MAKWANPUR (12 cases), LALITPUR (11 cases) and BARA (11 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (39 cases), KAILALI (30 cases), MORANG (29 cases), PARBAT (23 cases) and RUPANDEHI (19 cases).

**Cholera** case(s) were reported from PYUTHAN (1 case) and BHAKTAPUR (1 case).

Malaria case(s) were reported from KAILALI (2 cases) and RAUTAHAT (1 case).

Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (64 cases), SURKHET (50 cases), DANG (23 cases), PALPA (16 cases) and KHOTANG (12 cases).


Kala azar case(s) were reported from DOLPA (1 case) and MAHOTTARI (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from DANG (65 cases), TANAHU (32 cases), ROLPA (29 cases), BAJURA (24 cases) and SYANGJA (24 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from KAILALI (22 cases), PARSA (11 cases), BAJHANG (9 cases), BARA (9 cases) and KANCHANPUR (7 cases).

Most of the **Influenza Like Illness** cases were reported from PARBAT (79 cases), KAILALI (64 cases), DAILEKH (30 cases), ACHHAM (19 cases) and SINDHUPALCHOK (16 cases).
