


Highlights


Among the reported diseases, **SARI** is the leading cause of morbidity in Week 46 with **542 reported cases**.


Overall reporting rate of Week 46 is **94.0%** with **126 out of 134** sentinel sites reporting to EWARS.



This bulletin includes data since January 2023 till date, including comparison of the same period last two year. In May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and was gradually oriented and started reporting. Recently, in November 2024, 17 reporting sites selected from all the provinces of Nepal were upgraded to sentinel sites, thus the number of sentinel sites have increased. The current number of sentinel sites is 134.

Summary Observation (including probable and suspect cases)

Most of the **AGE** cases were reported from PARSA (23 cases), KATHMANDU (17 cases), KAPILBASTU (13 cases), KAVREPALANCHOK (9 cases) and BHAKTAPUR (9 cases).

Most of the **SARI** cases were reported from MORANG (47 cases), KATHMANDU (34 cases), RUPANDEHI (31 cases), KAILALI (26 cases) and PALPA (19 cases).

Cholera case(s) were reported from DOLAKHA (1 case) and KHOTANG (1 case).

Most of the **Malaria** cases were reported from KAILALI (2 cases), RAUTAHAT (1 case), SARLAHI (1 case), MORANG (1 case) and JHAPA (1 case).


Most of the **Dengue** cases were reported from KATHMANDU (54 cases), LAMJUNG (13 cases), DANG (13 cases), KAILALI (12 cases) and LALITPUR (9 cases).

Kala azar case(s) were reported from TERHATHUM (1 case).

Most of the **Scrub Typhus** cases were reported from DANG (57 cases), SALYAN (16 cases), ROLPA (12 cases), KATHMANDU (11 cases) and BHOJPUR (10 cases).

Most of the **Enteric Fever** cases were reported from KAILALI (13 cases), PARSA (9 cases), SARLAHI (6 cases), BARA (5 cases) and JHAPA (5 cases).
