# Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)

## Weekly Bulletin

(5th Epidemiological Week)

### **10 February 2019**



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This bulletin includes the updates from the Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS). It includes data since January 2019 till date, including comparison of same period during last year.

#### The Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)

#### **Highlights**

AGE: 301 cases of AGE are reported this week. The majority of these cases are from Kanchanpur (94 cases).

**SARI:** 161 cases of SARI are reported this week. The majority of these cases are from Morang (21 cases). Two deaths from SARI are reported from Patan Hospital, Lalitpur and the cases are from Lagankhel and Kusunti, Lalitpur.


**Kala-azar:** Four cases of Kala-azar are reported this week, one each from Bardiya, Kailali, Palpa and Syangja. One death from Kala-azar is reported this week from Teku hospital, Kathmandu and the case was from Palpa district.

Scrub typhus: One case of Scrub typhus is reported this week from Dhading.

The EWARS was established in 1997 to strengthen the flow of information on vector-borne and other outbreak prone infectious diseases from the district to Epidemiology and Disease Control Division (EDCD) and Vector-Borne Disease Research and Training Center (VBDRTC), Hetauda. Rapid Response Teams (RRTs) can be mobilized at short notice to facilitate prompt outbreak response at Central, Regional and District level. RRTs can also support local level health institutions for investigation and outbreak control activities.


This information system is hospital-based and is currently operational in 69 hospitals (out of 82 sites) throughout Nepal (Figure 1). So far, the EWARS mainly focuses on the **weekly reporting** of number of cases and deaths (including "zero" reports) of six priority diseases/syndromes—Malaria, Kala-azar, Dengue, Acute Gastroenteritis (AGE), Cholera and Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI), and other epidemic potential diseases/syndromes (like enteric fever). It equally focuses on **immediate reporting** (to be reported within 24 hours of diagnosis) of one confirmed case of Cholera, Kala-azar severe and complicated Malaria and one suspect/clinical case of Dengue as well as 5 or more cases of AGE and SARI from the same geographical locality in one-week period.






#### **Reporting Status**


Out of 69 functional EWARS sentinel sites, report was received from 33 sentinel sites (48%) whereas 36 sentinel sites did not report in the 5th epidemiological week of 2019. The reporting coverage has decreased compared to the last week.





#### 1.1 Acute Gastro-Enteritis and Cholera


301 cases of AGE are reported in the 5th epidemiological week of 2019. The majority of these cases are from Kanchanpur (94 cases), Saptari (32 cases), Achham (23 cases) and Dolakha (13 cases). 236 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2018.



#### 1.2 Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

161 cases of SARI are reported in the 5th epidemiological week this year. The majority of these cases are from Morang (21 cases), Lalitpur (18 cases), Jhapa (17 cases) and Saptari (16 cases). 238 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2018.

Two deaths from SARI are reported this week from Patan Hospital, Lalitpur and the cases were from Lagankhel and Kusunti, Lalitpur.



#### 1.3 Enteric Fever

26 cases of Enteric fever are reported this week. The majority of the cases are from Lamjung (5 cases), Dhading (3 cases) and Sindhuli (2 cases). No death from Enteric fever is reported so far this year.

#### 1.4 Malaria

No case of Malaria is reported this week. Similarly, no case of Malaria was reported this week in 2018.

#### 1.5 Dengue

No case of Dengue is reported this week. Similarly, no case of Dengue was reported this week in 2018.

#### 1.6 Kala-azar

Four cases of Kala-azar are reported this week, one each from Bardiya, Kailali, Palpa and Syangja. One death from Kala-azar is reported this week from Teku hospital, Kathmandu and the case was from Palpa district.

#### 1.7 Scrub typhus

One case of Scrub typhus is reported this week from Dhading.
